Dear Resident,

Nottingham Castle Coronation and Eurovision Screenings

We are writing regarding to you to advise on arrangements for the upcoming events at Nottingham Castle and to assure you that we prioritise keeping any impact on local residents to a minimum.

To mark the Coronation of King Charles III, we will be screening on 28m² screen the Coronation on Saturday 6th May and the Coronation Concert and Sunday 7th May. A screening of the Eurovision final on Saturday 13th May will conclude this short programme of Castle re-opening events.

Coronation of King Charles III: Gates open at 10:00, expected finish time 15:00

Coronation concert: Gates open at 19:00, expected finish time 23:00

Eurovision final: Gates open at 18:00, expected finish time 0:30

All events are ticketed. The Coronation and Coronation screenings are both picnic style events and will have a capacity of 1500 people, whilst the Eurovision final will be a concert style screening with a capacity of 2000 people.

Work on the site will commence on Thursday 4th May with all event infrastructure is expected to be removed by Monday 15th May. There will be no overnight working.

Any testing of PA equipment will be kept to a minimum and will take place on Friday 5th May ending no later than 20:00 and two hours prior to doors on event days. During the event sound levels will be closely monitored and regulated to ensure they remain within agreed Premises Licence limits.

Security and stewards will be present during all events, including regular patrols outside of the venue. No alcohol will be allowed to be taken outside of the Castle grounds.

To ensure attendee safety, a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) will be in place on Lenton Road from the junction of Friar Lane and the entrance to the Park Estate to prevent cars from picking up, dropping off or parking adjacent to the event entrance and exit. The TTRO is in place all day on Saturday 6th and Sunday 7th and on Saturday 13th May between 18:00-01:00.

There will be no public parking within the Castle grounds, with all visitors and staff making use of city centre parking facilities.
